An executive committee oversees the work of National Irish Safety Organisation which includes representatives from the regions as well as nominees from the Health and Safety Authority, Ibec, the Irish Congress of Trade Unions and Insurance Ireland.

The Law in Ireland

The Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act 2005 and the resulting regulations set out very clear responsibilities and legal duties for employers, employees and others in every workplace. Everyone has a particular responsibility for health and safety and it is important for business owners, managers, workers, safety representatives, the self-employed, contractors, suppliers, designers and manufacturers to be aware of what they are expected to do in this regard and to be appropriately briefed or trained.

The Relationship between the Health and Safety Authority and National Irish Safety Organisation

National Irish Safety Organisation, a voluntary body with charitable status, complements the role of the Health and Safety Authority (HSA), the statutory body for enforcing health and safety at work through its inspectorate. A nominee from the HSA sits on the executive committee of NISO but the two organisations are independent of one another. Our courses and seminars will outline the law as enforced by the HSA.

Who should join the National Irish Safety Organisation?
